

# **RESEARCH QUESTIONS:**

- (1) What are the perceived trade-offs between security and privacy?
- (2) How much attention is paid to security and risk in the Czech media content?
- (3) Who are the proponents and opponents of security vs. freedom?
- (4) How are the security related issues communicated with the citizens via media?





# **METHODOLOGY:**

- qualitative comparative analysis (Atlas.ti)
- Prague Graduate School in Comparative Qualitative
- 40 articles from right (MF Dnes) and leftoriented newspapers (Právo)
- I January 2010 and 30 April 2013
- WHO (actor), WHAT (topic), HOW (argumentative strategy), WHY (justification)

'You always have to pay for safety. CCTV cameras are just a small personal limitation that helps to increase the security of society...' (Rovenský 2011).





'The effort to stop the risk of a possible terrorist attack could raise another treat for human life with the same probability' (Právo 2010).









