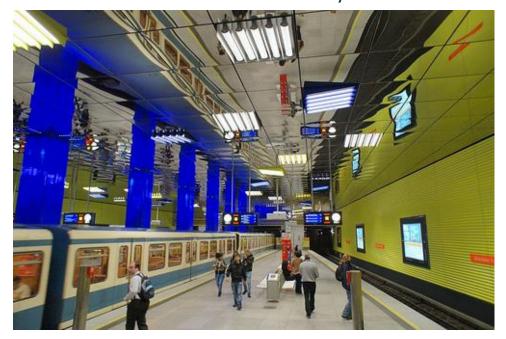
### What's at stake?

- Security issues are complex in nature
- Graffiti, pick-pocketing, anti-social behaviour...gives passengers a feeling of insecurity
- If passengers feel insecure they may avoid PT
- PT operator loses custom, more cars on roads, more pollution, more accidents...
- Reputation of network is volatile and affected disproportionately by incidents inside and outside the network



What's the solution?

- Security layers
  - Hard measures improving actual security: (video surveillance, security staff etc)
  - Soft measures improving perception of security (lighting, CPTED, music etc)
